

Traveller's Delight

Nainital+ Binsar+Corbett

Duration : 5n / 6d

Proposed Itinerary:

Day 1: Arrival at KathGodam and transfer to Nainital(25Kms/45mins): On arrival at KathGodam station, you will be picked up and transferred to Nainital. Check in at Nainital hotel and refresh.

Afternoon visit to the most prominent of the lake, Naini Lake, ringed by hills, obtain flows from catchments, which consists of the hill slopes and springs. The captivating lake is a major spot in Nainital. It provides opportunity of boating through yachts, paddle boats and traditional rowing boats (optional as per your choice). More beautiful, however is the lake at night when the myriads of bulbs from the hill sides and quite a large no. of hanging around the lake edges. Do local shopping at the Tibetan market. Go for some good designer candles made locally.

Dinner and overnight (Nainital).

Day 2: Nainital Lakes: After breakfast drive for lake tour of Bhim Tal, Sat Tal, Naukuchia Tal. Back in the evening.

Bhim tal is at a distance of 24 km from Nainital town and is set at almost the same altitude of 1375 mts above sea level as Sattal just 2 km away and is about 22 mts deep. This Lake was named after the legendary Bhim of the Mahabharata epic who came here to visit the five Pandava Brothers when they had lived here through their exile period. The main point that attracts people here is a small Island located in the heart of this freshwater lake and about 91 mts from the shore that holds a small aquarium to tourists. You can reach this Island by boat, spend time here and then boat back to land.

Sat tal is situated at a distance of 22 km from Nainital set at an altitude of 1370 mts above sea level. The Lake was named 'Sattal' which means 'Seven Lakes' as there are a total of seven small lakes named 'Ram Tal', 'Laxman Tal', 'Sita Tal', 'Purna Tal', 'Nal-Damyanti Tal', 'Garud Tal' and 'Sukha Tal', after great legends that mystically joins and connects with each other to form this natural freshwater lake measuring about 2 to 3 km and 20 mts deep. 'Khudariya Tal' now known as 'Sukha Tal' which means 'Dry Lake' was renamed as the entire water from this lake had leaked out towards the western extreme region of the main Lake. These lakes are fringed with dense Oak and Pine Forests and often home to migratory birds from across that live here due to its unspoiled and unpolluted fresh water.

Naukuchiya tal lies 28 km from Nainital and 4 km from Bhimtal elevated at 1220 mts above sea level, hence, you can trek right from Khurpatal to this Lake via Sattal and Bhimtal in order to view all the Lakes at one stretch of your journey. This beautiful Lake measures 1 km in length and 0.5 km in width and 40 mts deep. The name of this Lake means 'Nine Corners Lake' as it has nine corners and a myth states that if you can see all these nine corners in one shot, you will disappear into thin air and that sounds certainly challenging and might throw you off your limits which only feeds your curiosity but definitely not your courage while some may just try to prove it wrong. However, when

you visit this Lake you will realise that it is impossible to view all these nine corners at one time and the best thing to do is just enjoy its serene environs decorated with lush green forests and a variety of flora and fauna.

Come back Nainital in the evening. Spend leisure time around shopping.

Dinner and overnight (Nainital).

Day 3: Nainital to Binsar (98kms/2hrs): After breakfast, proceed towards Binsar via Almora sightseeings, Chati Temple. Binsar offers salubrious climate during summers with unobstructed views of the Himalayas. The weather of Binsar remains pleasant during summers and light woollens are required. Binsar is perched on top of the Jhandi Dhar hills and completely surrounded by dense forests. Oak, rhododendron, pine and deodar grow in amazing abundance.

Upon arrival at Binsar, you will be transferred to the hotel. Freshen up and relax. Later enjoy sightseeing, nature walk, wildlife viewing and birding at Binsar. Breathe in fresh air. Binsar Wildlife Sanctuary is popular among nature lovers and wildlife enthusiasts with its rich natural surroundings among thick forest.

Dinner and overnight (Binsar).

Day 4: Binsar to Corbett (165kms/4hrs)

Early morning check out after hearty breakfast from Binsar and proceed for Corbett Wildlife Sanctuary, is one of the best known tiger reserves in the country, first national park spreads over an area of 520 sq km. Corbett is known to be the highest density of tiger in India. Other animals include the leopard, elephant, bear, deer. Basking along the banks of the Ramganga are the slender snouted gharial and the marsh crocodile. There are watch towers, elephant safaris and jeep safaris for wildlife viewing.

Relax at your own.

Dinner and overnight (Corbett).

Note: There are only 2 time windows for safari. Morning (6-11), evening (2-7). Go for the morning one the next day.

Day 5: Corbett Morning Safari (Booking at your own)

Experience the Morning Safari.

You can explore the richness of flora and fauna with the Safari that unfolds the beauty of the Jim Corbett Park. Wildlife Safari of this park is a delight for adventure lovers and wildlife photographers. Away from the confines of mundane life, the Corbett Jeep safari is a journey into the world that is still untouched by mechanization. Several species of deer, sloth bear, wild boar, fresh water dolphin, leopard, the marsh mugger and gharial crocodiles, over 450 species of birds and the elusive, nocturnal Royal Bengal tiger... you can find them at the verdant Jim Corbett National Park.

Corbett National Park Wildlife Jeep Safari Timings: The park normally opens at 0600 hrs in the morning and is open till about 1100 hrs in the morning. In the afternoon the park timings usually are from 1430 to 1730. However depending on the season the timings change locally which the forest authorities of Corbett National Park notify.

Best Time to visit Corbett National Park: One can visit Jim corbett National park and do the wildlife day safari anytime round the year, depending upon his convenience and purpose of visit. However the best time to come to corbett National park is between October to June every year.

Winter (September - March): Days are clear and pleasant, Nights get cold. Great time for bird-

watching and Tiger sighting in Corbett National Park.

Summer (April to June): Hot days with pleasant nights. Ideal time for sighting animals, especially elephants and Tigers in Corbett National Park.

Dinner and overnight (Corbett).

Day 6: Corbett to KathGodam station (150kms/3hrs):

Relax get up, refresh and breakfast. Morning at your own till schedule checkout time. Checkout and drive to KathGodam Station.
